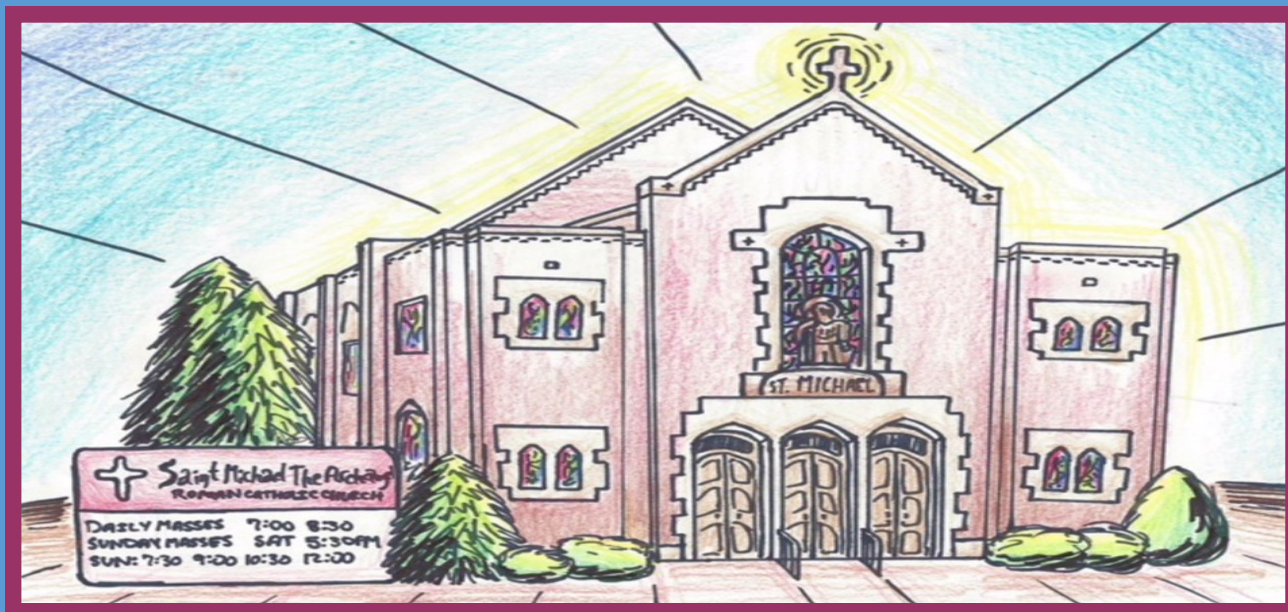

Gal 6:14-18 The heart of the Gospel is not circumcision but Christ's crucifixion.

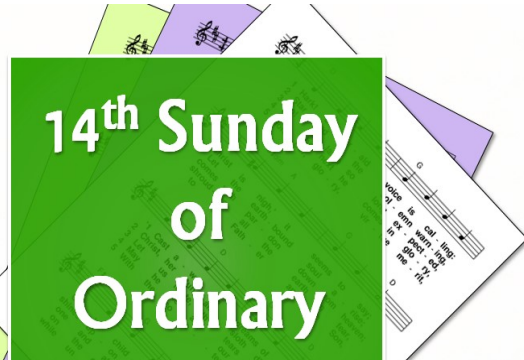
Lk 10:1-12, 17-20 The disciples are sent to spread the Gospel to the world.

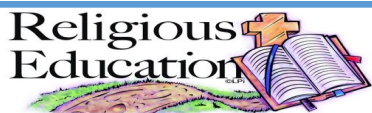



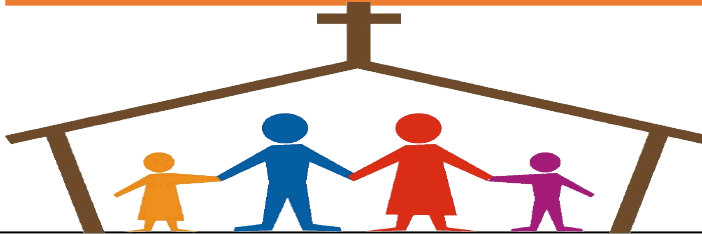
