





KEVIN APUZZIO August 2, 1984—April 11, 2006

On Thursday, December 6, 2018, St. Michael's Church and St. Michael's Parish School came together to dedicate the Lower Church classrooms in honor of East Franklin firefighter, **KEVIN APUZZIO**, who was tragically killed in the line of duty on Tuesday, April 11, 2006 trying to save a couple from a burning building. Kevin made the ultimate sacrifice for a person he had never met before. He was only 21 years old. Kevin attended St. Michael's School and was an Altar Server for St. Michael's Church.

A plaque was presented by the student council honoring Kevin Apuzzio. In attendance at the dedication ceremony were Dr. Joseph Apuzzio, Mrs. Marili Apuzzio, firefighters from the Union Fire Department and East Franklin Fire Department, Msgr. Anselm, Fr. Chuck, Fr. Miles, staff members of St. Michael's Church, principal, teachers and students.

The plaque and his picture can be found hanging above the door entering the Lower Church. It serves as a reminder that he is always by our side.
