The process has been simplified. You will be directed to your profile to enter an Emergency Contact, advise of any Allergies / IEPs for your child(ren) and provide any changes, like a change of address or phone number. You can also add another student, e.g., if you have a first grader entering the program for the first time. You will need to check that you have read and agree to our 2023-2024 Policies and Procedures. Please register early to take advantage of the **discounted fee**. If you know of someone who has a child entering the first grade, please ask them to contact the Religious Education Office. Special classes are available for older students who haven't had any prior religious instruction.
