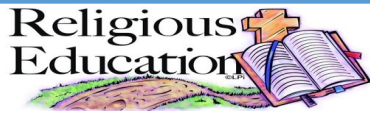
"SOS COLLECTION"

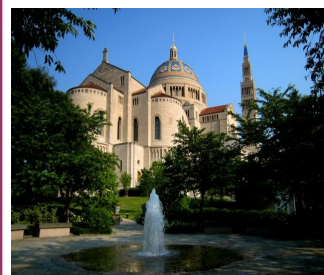


