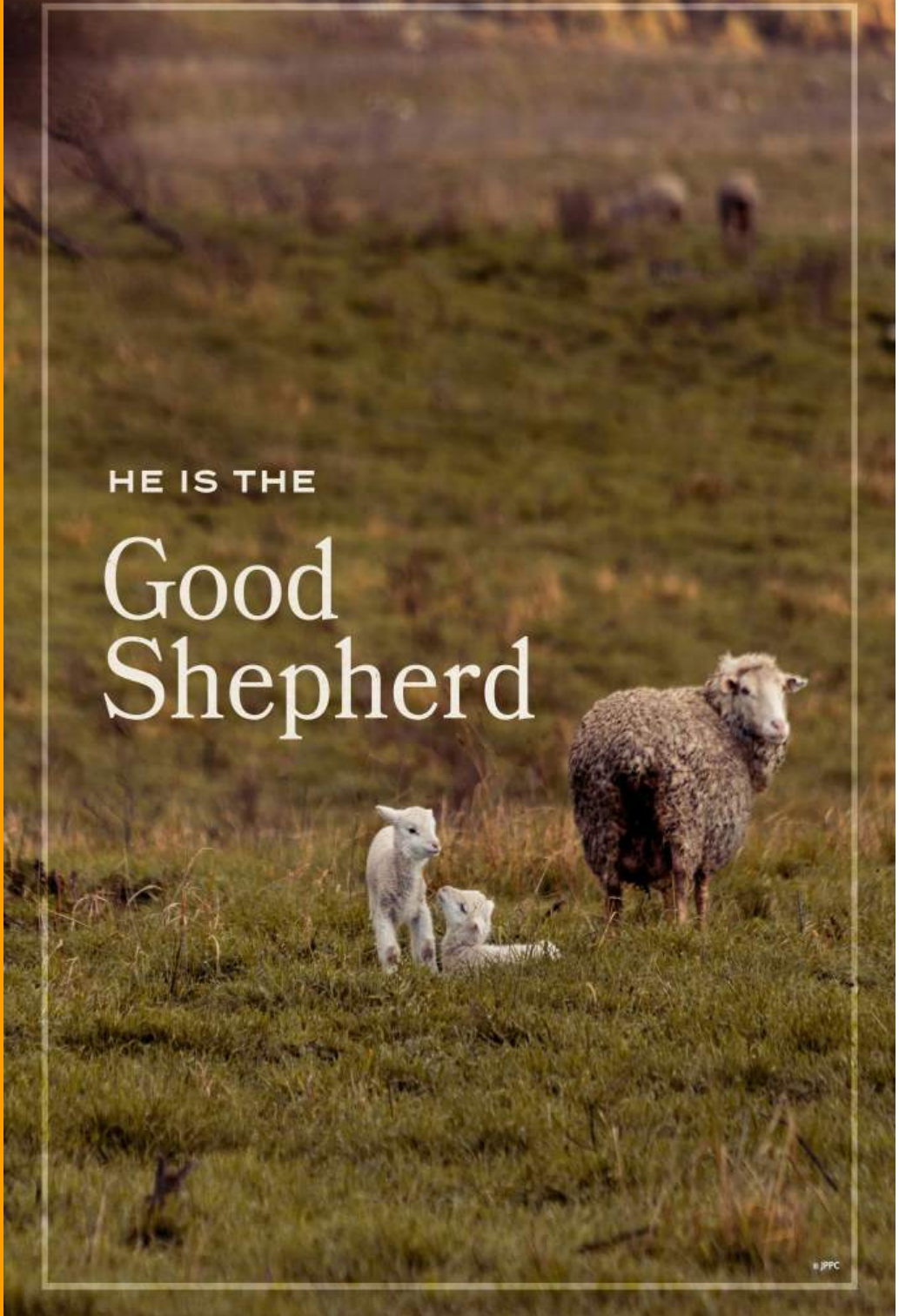

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER



Christ, Influencer Like No Other



In the gospel reading of this 4th Sunday of Easter (John 10:11-18), Christ calls Himself the Good Shepherd, that His sheep knows Him and He knows them, and that they follow His voice. My friends,

whom we follow and what we follow can make a huge difference in life. These days, we follow celebrities and influencers on Twitter, Instagram, Facebook, etc. I have always wondered how these people can save, heal, or even care for my needs. There is the story of a man who got to the wake service of his friend only to see two people there. He turned to the funeral director and said, "I thought there would have been many more people here because he had over 10,000 friends on Facebook". Hmm, welcome to the reality of social media! But there is a celebrity, an influencer, and a shepherd worth following--
#ChristJesus. Everything about Him is good news for us.

In the first place, He has been around forever, as Scripture says, "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God... and nothing was created without the Word... and the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:1-14). So "Nothing in all creation is hidden from His sight. Everything is laid bare before His eyes" (Heb. 4:13). So, this Shepherd knows it all, has seen it all, and nothing surprises Him, as Scripture says, "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not fall" (Heb. 4:15). Simply put, this Shepherd understands our pains and joys, knows the pains of betrayal and abandonment, what grief and bereavement feel like, what makes people cry, depressed, hopeless, or even lose it, what fear, anger, wrath, and hatred can do, what poverty

and riches can cause, etc. He also knows the liberating power of love, forgiveness, charity, compassion, self-donation, and care. He knows how things work and how to fix them when they don't. No wonder Scripture says, "Approach the throne of God's grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace for needed help". When Christ is your Shepherd, you have hired, so to say, an ever-present help in times of great need. I am not saying He will do everything you ask for, but indeed, He can do anything for you.

It is also important to note that with Jesus, we are never lost to His presence. Most celebrities we follow on social media don't even know who we are. But Jesus knows you by name; He knows what hurts and helps; He knows what you are good at and struggling with; He knows where you have been and where you are going. You are very special to Him. Scripture says, "This is what the Lord says— 'I have called you by name; you are mine.'" He is the Person you do not need to impress and, in whose presence, you do not need to pretend or be what or who you are not. He wants the best outcomes for you, as Scripture says, "For I know the plans I have for you; plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a future full of hope" (Jer. 29:11). He is the one who easily can change mourning into dancing, sorrow into joy, weeping into songs. Let us, therefore, take this Shepherd up on His word and make Him our Lord and personal Savior.

Stewardship of Treasure

April 9th, 2024

My dear Parishioner,

Let me start by thanking you for what we have been able to accomplish since I became the pastor of this Parish. As you may know, for the past four years, we have been able to balance our budget, take care of our bills, grounds, and all kinds of renovations, improvements, and new installations in our buildings, and remained financially solvent. This has been, largely, due to God's blessings upon us and the success of our one and only yearly campaign—St Michael's Church **Union of Saints and Nations Fundraiser (USAN)**. When I arrived here in July 2017, there were so many mini fundraising events that had turned the Vestibule of our Church into a market place, which in many ways detracted from the sanctity of our worship environment. I did not like this for our Church. So, in prayer, we initiated this yearly single fundraising event, to take care of our Church. Thank God, it has been a huge success in meeting our needs.

Now, the time is upon us to run this year's campaign, the purpose of which is to continue to balance our budget, maintain our buildings, convert the heating system in the Parish Rectory buildings from oil to gas (which will save us a tremendous amount of money), and to generate revenue-reserves for emergencies. As always, our target goal, for this fiscal year ending June 30th, 2024, is \$100,000.00 (One hundred thousand dollars).

For us to run this mission successfully, we need to form a minimum of 50+ groups, with each group targeting to raise a minimum of \$2000 (Two Thousand dollars). Facilitators are charged with these groups. We need parishioners to facilitate these groups. Without these facilitators, we may not be able to reach our goals. All that a facilitator has to do is to coordinate the members of his or her group to reach the targeted goal. Parishioners will be assigned to facilitators to form their groups. Also, an individual, a couple, a family, or friends held together by some common interest like religious devotion, socio-cultural background, or national allegiance, can form a group of their own. Generally, groups choose a name by which they are named. Groups can also recruit members from family, co-workers, and friends. When you get a call from a parish facilitator, please know that the call is not a scam. If you are in doubt, do please call the parish office at 908-688-1232.

Many individuals and families who choose to be stand-alone groups write a check for the target amount. Some groups organize internal fundraisers or ask group members for a minimum contribution to meet the group's target amount. Whatever the initiative may be, please do what you can to ensure the success of your group. All monies gifted to this campaign are tax deductible.

I urge all our parishioners to stand tall and stand committed to this blessed effort. We can accomplish any goal if we do it together. How glorious it would be if we all can commit, as individuals, to do whatever we can for the success of this year's USAN.

May the good Lord continue to bless you as you graciously participate in this kingdom work for His Church at St. Michael's Parish.
