Persistence: A Key to Success

The gospel reading for this 25th Sunday in ordinary times, Year A (Matthew 20:1-16), is about a land-owner who went out to the marketplace, at different hours of the day, to hire laborers for his vineyard. Amazingly, when out around 5:00 p.m., an hour before the end of the workday, he saw some laborers still standing and waiting to be hired. Guess what? They were hired and they got a full day's pay.

It is amazing what a persistent and unyielding spirit—refusing to give up, hanging in there in faith, believing God for His grace, determined to succeed—can do. Scripture says, “My faithful one shall live by faith and if he draws back, I have no pleasure in him” and in another place, it says: “Whoever puts his hand on the plow and keeps looking back is not worthy of the kingdom of heaven”. To be successful, our hunger and desire for success must be greater than our fear of failure and willingness to give up. Success demands that we allow commitment, courage, and persistence to coach our ambition and efforts. Our aspirations in life will, inevitably, be met with resistance and pullbacks; things that can dampen and discourage enthusiasm, deem the light of ambition, and push efforts into the alternate direction of quitting. Many a time, it takes grace and believing-faith to cross the breaking line; the divide between success and failure. The question is: how do we react in the face of seeming failure? What do we do with the bricks and stones that life and others throw on the path of our goals and dreams? Do we use them to build bridges to crossover the huddles and build ladders to climb to new heights, or do we use them to build walls that close us in and cause us to sink deeper and deeper into failure?

My friends, there are big rewards in learning how to keep going, no matter what, because hardest times often lead to the greatest moments in life. Losing hope never cuts it because storms never last forever. The best way to get out of a situation is to get through it. Therefore, when the going gets tough, let us put one foot in front of the other and just keep going. Who knows, by the time we turn around, we may have climbed a mountain. It was Calvin Coolidge who said, “Nothing in this world can take the place of persistence. Talent will not; nothing is more common than unsuccessful men with talent. Genius will not; unrewarded genius is almost a proverb. Education will not; the world is full of educated derelicts. Persistence and determination alone are omnipotent. The slogan 'Press On!' has solved and always will solve the problems of the human race.” These few words say it all. The 5:00 p.m. workers hung in there and were handsomely rewarded. Persistence always pays off, big time. May the good Lord grant us the spirit of persistence in things of heaven above and here below!

May God grant us the grace to persevere in our endeavors! May He bless and grant success to our efforts in this life! May He reward our faith and hope in Him, Amen.

ST. MICHAEL'S COLLECTIONS

Below is an explanation of some of the different St. Michael's Collections:

S.O.S. Collection - This is a monthly "restricted" collection dedicated to paying our utility bills. **Restricted collections are not assessed by the Archdiocese of Newark and therefore all funds are used solely by St. Michael's to pay our bills.** S.O.S. collections are appreciated at all times.

Tithing - This is a monthly "restricted" collection dedicated to paying for the new the upkeep of the Church boiler and airconditioner. **Restricted collections are not assessed by the Archdiocese and therefore all funds are used solely for St. Michael's needs.** Tithing collections are appreciated at all times.

Assessment Collection - The Archdiocese of Newark assesses all parishes in the Archdiocese, and a percentage of the parish's annual unrestricted revenue, is paid monthly. This assessment is used by the Archdiocese to support administrative services. St. Michael's has instituted a monthly "restricted" collection that is used solely for paying our monthly assessment. **All Assessment Collection funds are sent directly to Archdiocese of Newark, monthly, to pay our Assessment Obligation. No funds are used for St. Michael's needs.**

National Collections - the Archdiocese of Newark has ten collections during the year to benefit various organizations such as the retired priest's fund, the church in Eastern Europe, the religious retirement fund, and mission appeals. **Money from the national collections go directly to the Archdiocese of Newark.**

St. Vincent De Paul Collection - money donated to St. Vincent De Paul is distributed prior to Thanksgiving and prior to Easter to local foodbanks, soup kitchens and social centers that provide food and shelter for those in need.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

REGISTRATION FOR 2023/2024 – Classes began the week of September 17. A \$25 late fee will be incurred for registrations after that date. **Monday classes are full except for Grade 3.**

Call the Religious Education Office if you need assistance. Registration for in-person classes will not be accepted after October 15.

Religious Education begins in Grade 1 and continues through Grade 8. First Communion candidates must complete two years of Religious Education before receiving the sacrament. Confirmation is typically received in Grade 9 after completing the Religious Education program. **Missed years of Religious Education will require make-up assignments and assessment of readiness which may delay the reception of the sacrament in Grade 9.**

If you know of someone who has a child entering the first grade, please ask them to contact the Religious Education Office. Special classes are available for older students who haven't had any prior religious instruction.


