#### **GOSPEL READINGS AND REFLECTIONS**

*Reading* 1 1 *Kings* 3:5, 7-12

Imagine what you would say if God spoke to you in a dream and said, "Ask something of me and I will give it to you." Think of all the possible responses to an invitation like that! The young King Solomon knew that he could ask God for riches or power or victory over his enemies. But he asked instead for "an understanding heart." Young and inexperienced as he was, Solomon knew that the gift of understanding was much more valuable than gold or silver.

God was so pleased with the king's prayer that God gave Solomon the greatest wisdom a king had ever had. How often will you ask God for this precious gift of understanding?

#### **BAPTISM PREPARATION & BAPTISMS**

Baptism begins the Child's membership in the Catholic faith and first movement towards eternal salvation. This is the first sacrament of initiation into the Catholic faith. The other sacraments of initiation are Eucharist and Confirmation. The sacrament of Baptism frees the child from original sin and invites the Holy Spirit to dwell in the child. The child also receives the theological virtues of faith, hope and charity.

First time parents should visit the Parish Office to register in the parish. Baptisms are held every second Sunday of the month. Baptism preparation classes are held every second Friday of the month at 7:30 PM. Once your family is registered you can schedule the Baptism and Baptism preparation class. Classes usually last an hour. To obtain the true meaning of the Sacrament of Baptism, both parents are required to attend the class.

#### FEAST OF ST. MICHAEL



We will celebrate the Feast of St. Michael the Archangel by having a Dinner Dance on our feast day, Friday evening, *September 29, 2017 at Costa del Sol. Tickets are \$70.00 each* and are available in the Parish Center during the week and in the church vestibule on week-

#### **INVITATIONS TO VALIDATE MARRIAGES**

Is Your Marriage Valid?

If you are married civilly, that is not in the Catholic Church before a priest or deacon, it might not be a valid marriage. Some couples believe that a marriage before a Justice of the Peace or a non-Catholic minister is valid. For a marriage to be valid in the Catholic Church, the marriage must be in a Catholic Church or Chapel and officiated by an authorized Catholic priest or deacon along with 2 witnesses. (There are limited interfaith exceptions with proper permission.)

We invite you to speak with one of our priests if there are any questions or if indeed you wish to validate your marriage. The process can be very simple and your marriage will now be blessed by the Church.
