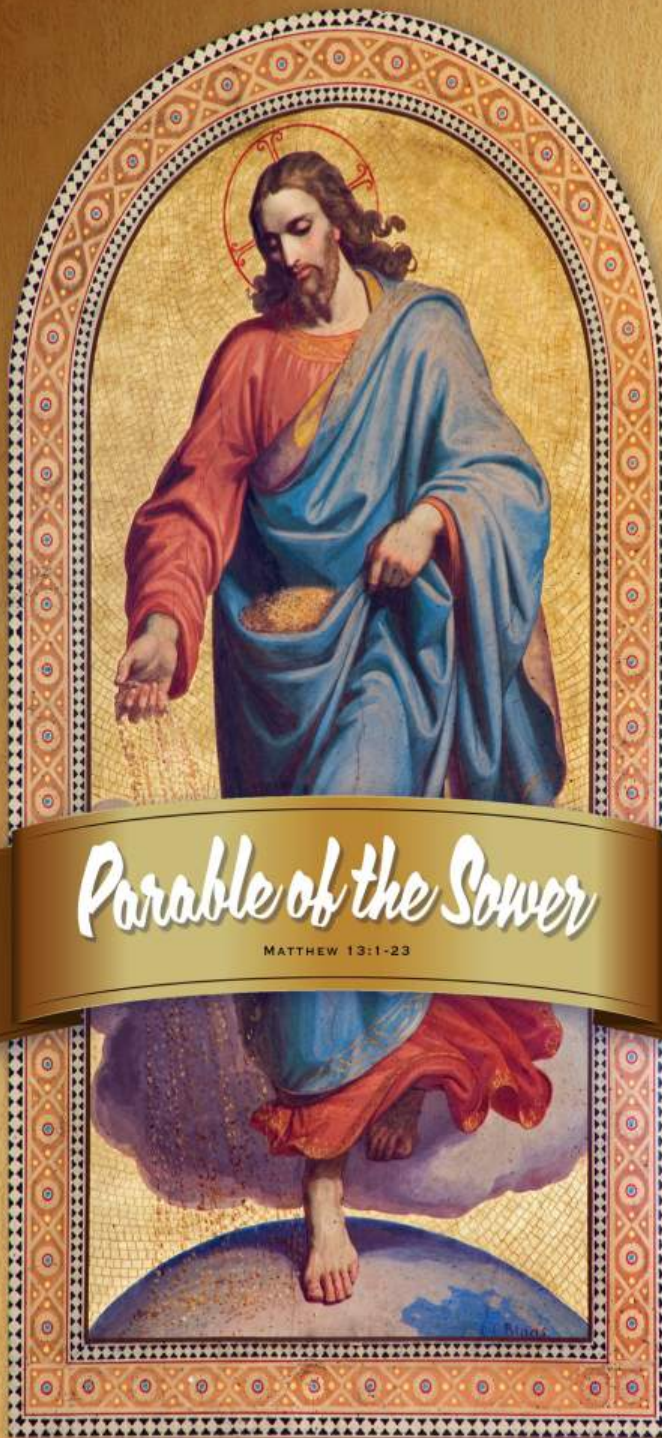

The Best in us Lies within Us

My dear Parishioners,

After I became your pastor, I expressed to you my disapproval of having many mini fundraisers going on in the vestibule of our Church that detracted, in my opinion, from the sanctity of our worship space. Thereupon, we decided to eliminate such transactions from our worship space and to have only one fundraiser, per year, to take care of the needs of our Church. So far, we have been highly rewarded with this decision as the success of our St. Michael's USAN—Union of Saints and Nations—campaign has brought us to a respectable place in the Archdiocese, having balanced our budget for three consecutive years. Time and time again, I have come to realize that if you don't climb a mountain, it is difficult to view the plains. But climbing a mountain is never easy and yet our motto continues to be, "Forward ever, backward never".

Our 2023 USAN campaign seems to have lost some momentum as we are very far away from our goal. Therefore, I am calling upon all our parishioners to come together and let us do the needful. All our facilitators need to push to meet their stated goal. All our parishioners need to rise up to this moment by supporting a group or sponsoring a stand-alone group, or make a direct donation to the Campaign. The minimum goal for each group is \$2,000 and our parish goal is **\$100,000.00** (One Hundred Thousand Dollars). I have no doubt, whatsoever, that we will, as in previous years, meet and surpass this goal. The good news is that we have the resources needed to accomplish this goal. The bad news is that the resources are still in your wallets.

Thank you, so very much, for taking responsibility for the financial health of our parish by helping this child of ours, St. Michael's Church, reach her financial goals. I truly believe that we are equal to this challenge and I am grateful to God for it. We will close our USAN campaign by the end of August.

May you all remain very blessed!

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

May the blessings of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you and your families.

On behalf of our pastor Msgr. Anselm Nwaorgu, we would like to give you an update on our UNION of SAINTS and NATIONS FUNDRAISER 2023 (USAN 2023), which is our church's sole annual fundraiser.

At present, we only have 38 groups formed with 38 facilitators or group leaders. We need to form a minimum of 50 groups to be able to achieve our fundraising goal of **\$100,000.00 (one hundred thousand)**. Each group is to raise \$2,000.00. We have raised **\$22,733** so far for this campaign period.

REGISTRATION FOR 2023/2024 Religious Education classes (Grades 1-8) is now open. Currently registered families should have received an email reminder to register directly from Parish Giving. The process has been simplified. You will be directed to your profile to enter an Emergency Contact, advise of any Allergies / IEPs for your child(ren) and provide any changes, like a change of address or phone number. You can also add another student, e.g., if you have a first grader entering the program for the first time.

You will need to check that you have read and agree to our 2023-2024 Policies and Procedures. This document, as well as a calendar of classes for the year, fee schedule, volunteer form and Parish registration form are available at stmichaelunion.org/religious-education.

NEW FAMILIES ONLY: If your child was not part of our program last year, please visit stmichaelunion.org/religious-education and follow the link to either in-person classes or home-based classes. Alternatively, you can print the .pdf registration form, fill it in and return it to the office, or come to the Religious Education Office and complete the process in person.

Please register early to take advantage of the discounted fee. If you know of someone who has a child entering the first grade, please ask them to contact the Religious Education Office. Special classes are available for older students who haven't had any prior religious instruction.
